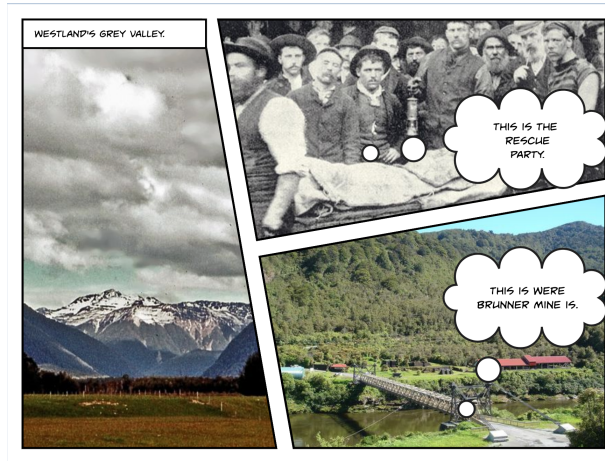
# Puawai

Below is a snapshot of what we have been up to with Book Creator.



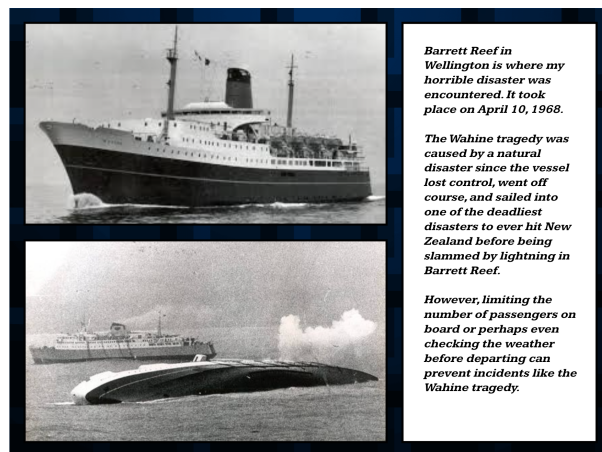
