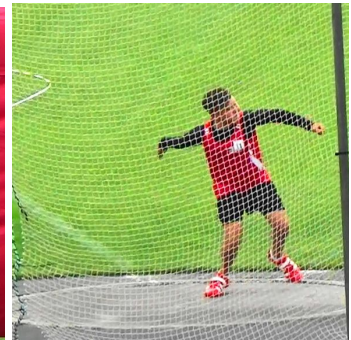
We are very proud of two students that have attended Waima School.

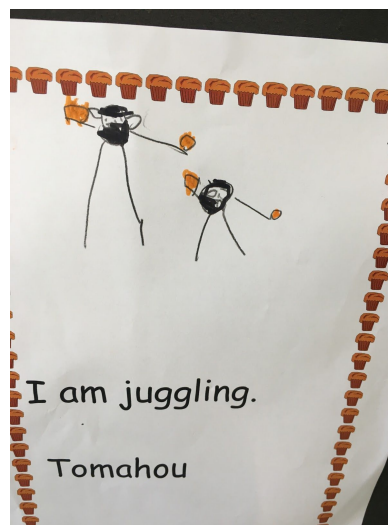
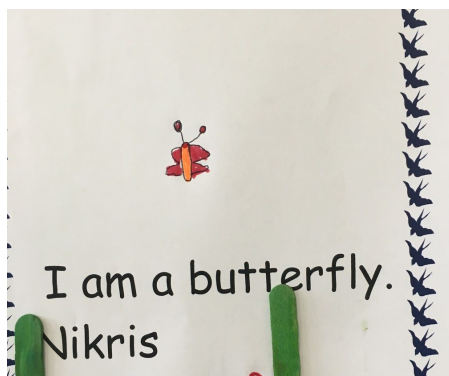
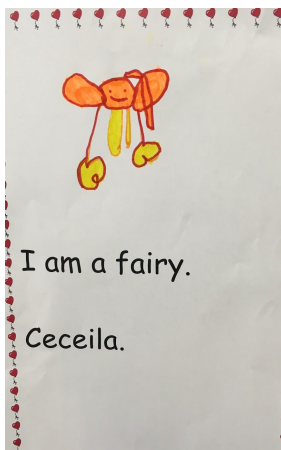
5.00pm - Children to meet at the pool with togs and towel

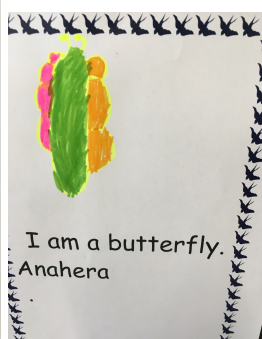
5.30pm - Sausage sizzle at the pool.

6.30pm - Home time!!

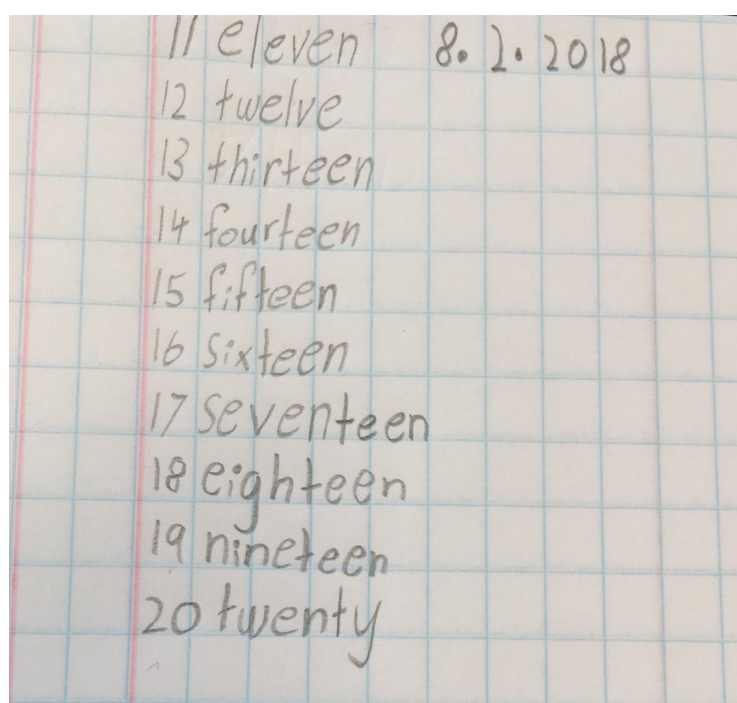
We will also have tables with various items of clothing out - adults and childrens. Free to a good home. Please come along with a bag and take what ever you would like.
