Nits - It is that time of year where we seem to have an infestation of nits. If you child has nits and you would like lotion then please call the office and we will send it home.

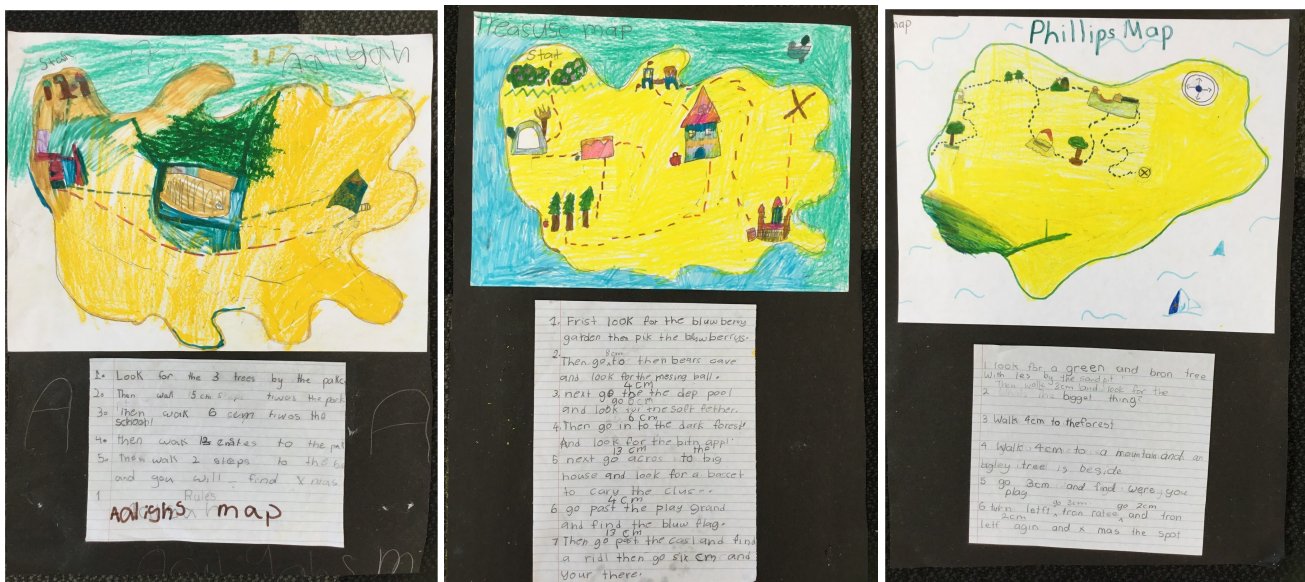
