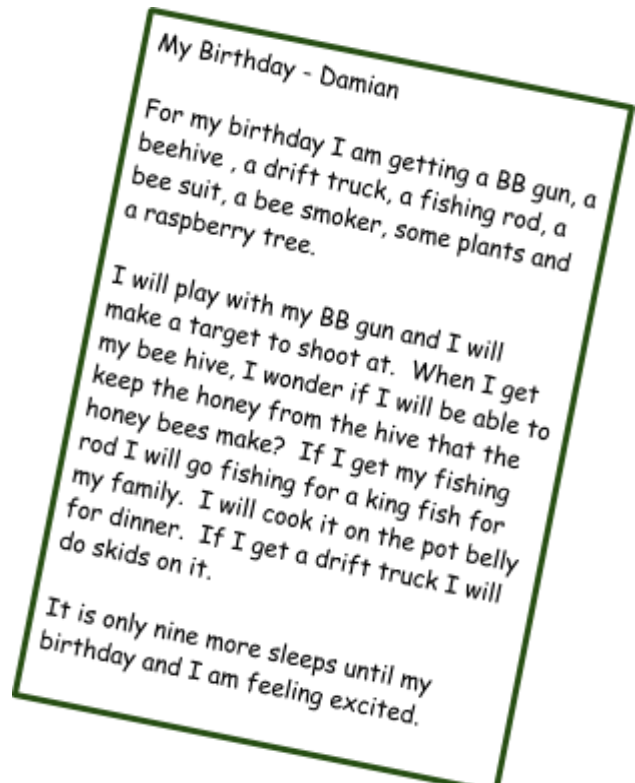


Ruma Tupu:


