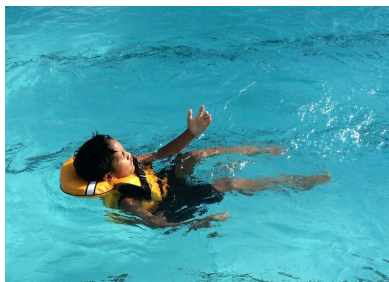
Puawai:
