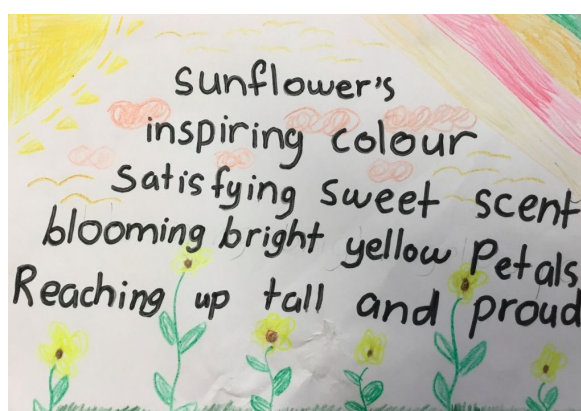

Ruma Tupu:

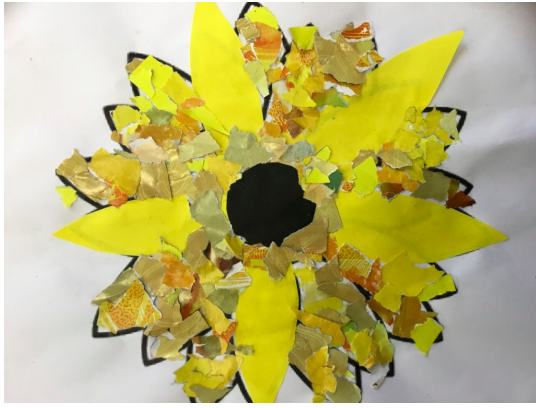

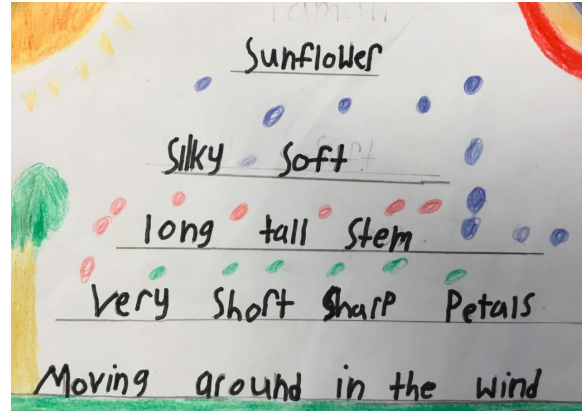

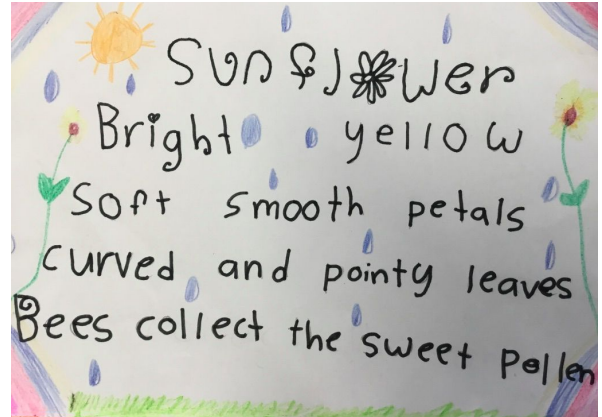

- ★ During lockdown we learnt to help do the chores so we can make things easier for our elders. We also did other fun stuff like gaming online against others. **Mauri**


